## SHOW REGULATIONS

**PRIVACY ACT:** If you do not want your name in the catalogue exhibitors list PLEASE state this on your entry form.

1. All exhibits to be the bone fide property of the exhibitor at the time of entry and exhibition.
2. Juniors. A junior exhibitor has to have, at the time of the show, attained the age of 8 years and be under 17 years.
3. Birds classed as cockerels or pullets must have been hatched after 30<sup>th</sup> June the previous year.
4. The Christchurch Poultry, Bantam and Pigeon Club (Inc) 1991 does not hold itself liable, nor in any way can it be held liable, for the non-payment and/or the incorrect award of prize monies, cups or other prizes offered by the specialist clubs in this schedule. All such prizes, cups, awards etc; are the sole responsibility of the specialist clubs themselves.
5. Exhibitors may with confidence send their best specimens, and the Club pledges itself to make the most careful arrangements for the proper care of the specimens sent, but the Club will not be liable for any accident, mistake, loss or damage, from whatever cause arising, the specimens being the sole risk of the exhibitor. The Club will feed and water all foreign exhibits on arrival. In case of the death of any specimen, it will be returned to the owner.  
Exhibitors **MUST NOTIFY** the secretary when not forwarding an exhibit or exhibits to the show.
6. Freight of exhibits must be pre-paid. The Club undertakes to convey all exhibits forwarded by freight to and from Christchurch depots free of charge. A competent person will attend all carriers advised to the club by exhibitors on the night before the show.
7. Unhealthy specimens will not be exhibited, but will be immediately returned to the owners, and the entry fees forfeited. **OBSERVE:** Carefully label all exhibits with a legible address. Give the name of the Club and senders name and address. Any further particulars about freight forwarders regulations for handling show exhibits should be obtained from the relevant forwarder. The Club will not be held responsible for the wrong delivery through inadequate addressing.
8. Specimens entered in the wrong class will be excluded from competition for prizes, the entry cancelled and entry fees forfeited. Entry fees for pens not occupied will be forfeited, and all such pens shall not be counted as in competition for any prizes. The Club reserves to itself the right to reject any entry or entries it may think fit, but the exhibitor has the right of appeal to the New Zealand (S.I.) Poultry, Pigeon & Cage Bird Association (Inc).
9. Exhibitors may state the price at which they will sell their specimens, and all sales must go through the Clubs books. Applications to purchase exhibits at the prices named in the catalogue must be lodged with the secretary, and exhibits will be at the time be sold on payment of the purchase money to the secretary, but cannot be removed from the pen or pens until the end of the show. Exhibits purchased during the show are the sole risk



of the purchaser from the time of purchase. In all cases 20% will be deducted from the amount paid to the seller. No sales may be made after 2:00pm on the final day of the show.

10. The judge will be instructed to determine the merits of all exhibits entered for competition in accordance with the standards of the New Zealand (S.I.) Poultry, Pigeon & Cage Bird Association (Inc.). The judges will be instructed to withhold prizes where they consider that there is insufficient merit. The decision of the judges shall be final, unless it can be proved to the satisfaction of the Club that the bird has been fraudulently tampered with, in which case a decision shall be void and the Club reserves to itself the right to adjudicate thereon. The judges will be instructed to pass and draw attention to any specimen with drawn, trimmed, painted or artificially-coloured plumage, or where any fraudulent practices have been used.
11. Birds found to be infested with pests or diseased will be excluded from competition.
12. All exhibits must be delivered and penned at the place of exhibition, Canterbury Table Tennis Stadium, 294 Blenheim Road, Riccarton on Thursday prior to the show, between the hours of 3:00pm and 9:00pm. This will not be strictly enforced in cases of exhibits arriving by transport, delayed by accident. Where exhibits are not forwarded, exhibitors must inform the club of their absence the day previous to the show.
13. The club reserves the right to accept or reject any entries submitted to it as per the Rules & Instructions of the New Zealand (S.I.) Poultry, Pigeon & Cage Bird Association (Inc.).
14. No exhibitor (other than appointed personnel) will be admitted to the body of the show building, prior to the hours of opening under any pretence whatsoever. The penning committee will control the receipt, penning and delivery of all exhibits. Each committee member will be empowered to act on the rules governing the regulation of the show. Definition of the Show Building This shall be the area on the North East of the building that is used to play table tennis on, not to include the carpeted area, the cafeteria or toilets.
15. No person other than the judge in his/her own section, or the stewards with the judges consent, shall be permitted to handle any birds at the show without the consent of the secretary or an executive member of the show body concerned, and then only in the presence of an executive member of the show body concerned.
16. Exhibits cannot be removed before 4.00 pm on Saturday 23rd June, please do not ask to remove them earlier as refusal may offend.
17. Exhibitors who do not receive their prize money or monies due from sale of exhibits within one month after the show are requested to communicate with the secretary of the association (K Cardno, 7 Johns Street, Oceanview, Dunedin 9035), who will bring the matter before the committee.
18. An American Show Racer is a fancy pigeon to be rung with a sealed ring for young bird classes to be sold by a recognised Fancy Pigeon Club or Association and are to be entered in the Fancy Pigeon Section and judged by the Officiating Fancy Pigeon Section Judge.  
A NZ Show Homer is a Homing Pigeon to be rung with a sealed ring sold by a recognised Homing Pigeon Club or Association and is to be entered in the Homing Pigeon Section and judged by the Officiating Homing Pigeon Section Judge.

- 19.** Pigeons should be rung with a ring recognised by any club or society. All other rings must be removed. A NZ Racing Homer is to be allowed to have an electronic recording ring as well as the sealed ring.
- 20.** The Club will not accept entry of birds bearing rings of foreign origin other than Australian, or illegally imported birds or birds bred there from. Imported young birds bearing Australian rings must be shown in adult classes.
- 21.** The Club advises that in entering birds in this show you give consent for photographs to be taken after all judging has been completed.
- 22.** The Committee of the Club reserve the right to refuse entries from any exhibitor.
- 23.** All exhibitors entering in open classes must pay open class entry fee.
